Core Truth:

In this Year of Praise, our highest worship is matched by our faithful, active

1. _____. True praise is a lifestyle of witnessing to a broken world from Monday to Sunday.

- I. Shift Your Focus — From Personal Timelines to Divine Purpose (Acts 1:6–7)
 - o The disciples were fixated on political restoration and earthly timelines (v. 6).
 - o Jesus redirects our focus: Stop obsessing over the 2. _____. align with God's eternal purpose (v. 7).
 - o Key Scripture: Proverbs 3:5–6; Matthew 6:33
- II. Receive the Fuel — Empowered by the Holy Spirit (Acts 1:8a)
 - o Matthew 28 provides the Mandate (Exousia = Divine Authority); Acts 1 provides the Might (Dunamis = Divine Power).
 - o Living for God in human strength leads to spiritual 3. _____. We must run on the power of the Holy Spirit.
 - o Key Scripture: Zechariah 4:6; 2 Timothy 1:7
- III. Expand the Sphere — Being Witnesses in Ever-Expanding Circles (Acts 1:8b)
 - o A witness doesn't fabricate evidence; a witness simply tells the 4. _____ about what Jesus has done.
 - o The Blueprint of Witnessing:
 - Jerusalem: Your immediate circle (family, co-workers, friends)
 - Judea: Your local region & familiar culture (neighborhood, city)
 - Samaria: People different from us / cross-cultural neighbors
 - Ends of the Earth: Global missions and unreached peoples
 - o Key Scripture: 1 Peter 3:15; Matthew 5:14–16
- IV. Embrace the Urgency — Moving from Looking Up to Stepping Out (Acts 1:9–11)
 - o Beware of Spiritual 5. _____ Syndrome—enjoying church without engaging the mission field.
 - o Jesus handed us the baton of the Great Commission; we must run our lap with holy urgency because He is 6. _____!
 - o Key Scripture: John 9:4; Titus 2:11–13; Hebrews 10:24–25
