


In 1739, a poem by Charles Wesley birthed one of the most beloved and familiar of all Christmas carols. The lyrics have been amended over time, most notably by fellow Methodist George Whitefield in 1754. It recounts the angels appearing to shepherds of Bethlehem to announce the birth of the Christ as described in Luke 2:8-14.



Wesley originally intended his poem to be sung to the tune of another Wesleyan hymn, the Easter ode Christ the Lord is Risen *Today*. But a century after Wesley's writing, a melody by German composer Felix Mendelssohn (commemorating Gutenberg's invention of movable type) provided the familiar tune for this hymn as we know & sing it today.



Though only the first stanza is widely known and sung today, this hymn actually consists of five stanzas, all replete with Biblical references and rich in theological significance. This year, as we advance through the five services of Advent, we'll study together the five stanzas of this song, and the wonderful witness they PRO-**CLAIM of Christ's coming to us** that is the event of Christmas.

# HARK! THE HERALD ANGELS SING | Luke 2:1-14

<sup>1</sup> In those days Caesar Augustus issued a decree that a census should be taken of the entire Roman world.... 4 So Joseph also went up from the town of Nazareth in Galilee to Judea, to Bethlehem the town of David, because he belonged to the house & line of David. <sup>5</sup> He went there to register with Mary, who was pledged to be married to him & was expecting a child. 6 While they were there, the time came for the baby to be born, 7 and she gave birth to her firstborn, a Son. She wrapped Him in cloths & placed Him in a manger, because there was no guest room available for them.

#### 2 Corinthians 5:18-21

<sup>18</sup> All this is from God, who reconciled us to Himself through Christ & gave us the ministry of reconciliation: <sup>19</sup> that God was reconciling the world to Himself in Christ, not counting people's sins against them. And He has committed to us the message of reconciliation. <sup>20</sup> We are therefore Christ's ambassadors, as though God were making His appeal through us.
